In 2025, the Caitlin Clark
Foundation partnered with Musco
Lighting to introduce four new
community courts to Des Moines
Public Schools. More than just
playing courts, these are quickly
becoming community hubs where
kids can play soccer, basketball,
and futsal, connect with friends,
and learn life skills that go far
beyond the game.

Located at Hiatt, Callanan, McCombs, and Weeks Middle Schools, the courts feature custom surfacing, built-in hoops and goals, benches, ADA accessibility, and evening lighting, ensuring the fun doesn't stop when the sun goes down.

BACK TO SCHOOL BACKPACKS

PREPARING KIDS FOR A YEAR OF LEARNING

For two years now, the Caitlin Clark Foundation has helped students step into the new school year prepared and confident. Partnering with local organizations, we have delivered backpacks filled with essential school supplies to hundreds of kids, helping them to start the new school year with the right momentum.

What started as a simple way to support our education pillar has grown into a valued tradition. Each backpack represents more than notebooks and pencils—it is a small but powerful step toward creating equal opportunities in the classroom and giving every student the chance to start strong.



FOUR \$22,000 GRANTS HONORING JERSEY RETIREMENT

When Caitlin's #22 jersey was retired at the University of Iowa, she chose to celebrate with many by giving back. The Foundation awarded four \$22,000 grants to organizations that had shaped her college years.

The idea for these gifts came directly from Caitlin. In the weeks leading up to her jersey retirement, she identified the most meaningful and personal organizations whose work was part of shaping her during her college career. She wanted to honor the community that had supported her so wholeheartedly, and she knew exactly which organizations to choose.

- University of Iowa Children's Hospital Honoring the kids and families whose strength inspired her during countless visits.
- Boys and Girls Club of the Corridor Continuing her support for a safe, encouraging place for kids to learn and grow.
- Special Olympics Iowa East Central Inspired by Debbie Antonelli to celebrate athletes of all abilities and the joy that sports bring.
- Coralville Community Food Pantry Giving back to where her journey of service began.

"One of my favorite things about Iowa City is the way the community is connected and how everyone supports each other," said Caitlin following the announcement. "It's something I felt deeply during my time here, and it's something I want to stay connected with for the rest of my life. I'm proud to support each of these organizations and the meaningful impact they make for the people of Iowa."
